Easter Survey Results



It has been a difficult task collating and interpreting all the data for the recent survey so apologies for the delay, however the results can now be reported. It is worth reminding everyone that the prime reason Fr Jerald commissioned the survey was to see whether the liturgies met your spiritual requirements and how he and the Liturgy team can perhaps improve what we do and how we do it.

Considering the above, the response to the survey was rather disappointing in that of the 281 surveys handed out, only 27% were returned; however here is a quick summary.

The low attendance at the Reconciliation, Holy Thursday and Stations of the Cross Services was primarily due to the unsuitability of date and/or time. Most of those who attended were very satisfied with the services, rating them 8 and above. The Palm Sunday Mass was well attended (83% of respondents) and received, with ratings of 6 and above mostly. The attendances for Holy Week (Holy Thursday – Easter Sunday) ranged from 41% to 53% with 'away' being one of the main reasons for non-attendance. There appears to be some preference for Easter Sunday Mass with attendance of 53%, compared to the Vigil Mass at 40%. Most of those who attended the Holy Week Liturgies were satisfied with ratings of mostly 7 and above.

The Liturgy Team would like to thank all those parishioners who took the time to complete the Survey.
